Dr. Haraway grew up in an Irish Catholic and Methodist family in Denver where she often accompanied her father, sportswriter Frank Haraway, in the press box at Bears baseball games. She studied zoology, philosophy, and English at Colorado College and earned her PhD in biology at Yale. After teaching at the University of Hawaii and at Johns Hopkins University, she joined the History of Consciousness program at UC/Santa Cruz. Author of both "A Cyborg Manifesto" and *The Companion Species Manifesto*, her interdisciplinary work draws from biology, philosophy, science and technology studies, religious studies, feminist theory, cultural studies, and anthropology.
